The Each Home Counts Implementation Board held their monthly Board meeting on 1st June to give updates on the workstreams' implementation plans. This included discussions on the proposals for the quality mark which have been revised following stakeholder feedback from the Quality Mark Workshop led by Simon Ayers on May 18<sup>th</sup>.

The Board met again on 14th June to take part in a workshop to discuss solutions to some of the key challenges to implementation that have been identified so far. The session also included planning for a stakeholder event on 12th July in London. This event is to update industry and the wider stakeholder community on the progress each of the workstreams.
