

March 2017: Meeting note

The publication of the Each Home Counts Report marked the beginning of a new phase of the Review. The role of the Implementation Board is now about action and delivery, to focus on how we are going to take forward the recommendations in the Report and put them into practise.

The Review highlighted a range of challenges across the domestic energy efficiency and renewable energy sector. We now have an opportunity to work with stakeholders to transform the sector and develop a more professional industry that can deliver better value for consumers and promote growth.

This is not a Government-led plan. The recommendations in the Report have been made by industry and it is for industry to take them forward. We have the support of Government but this will be a genuine team effort and, ultimately, it is for us to make things happen.

The Implementation Board, chaired by Howard Porter, met on Thursday 2 March to provide updates on the work that has been done since the launch and to discuss future plans.

The Review Team are now preparing for the Spring workshop event where we will share and discuss draft implementation plans and delivery proposals.

There will also be some smaller events in the near future focusing on the advice and the quality mark workstreams.
